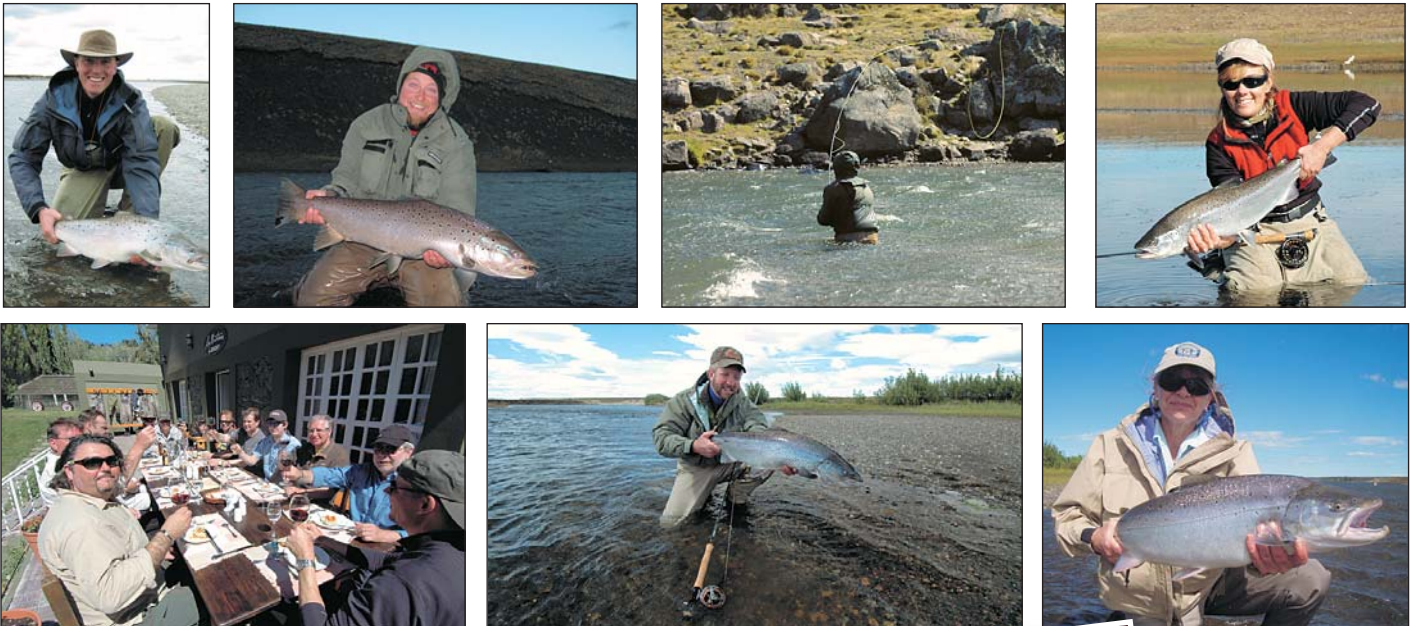

## LAS BUITERAS LODGE

The premier lodge for sea trout on the Rio Gallegos River in southern Patagonia



**A** trip to the Rio Gallegos River offers the adventurous angler the opportunity to pit his skills against the trout of Argentina. These fish can reach sizes of 25lbs and over and will reward the angler with arm wrenching takes and blistering runs, interspersed with regular acrobatic displays.

Las Buiteras lodge is home to the most prolific beats on the Rio Gallegos, consisting of over 40kms of private water comprising 50 named pools. The fishing is exciting and varied with pools ranging from deep stony runs to cut banks and streamy shingle flats. Relatively shallow, the river makes for easy wading, obviating the need for fast sinking lines and creating an exciting and challenging fishing environment. It is this variety in combination with the visually inspiring mountainous outcrops that makes this part of the Rio Gallegos

quite simply one of the most spectacular stretches of fly fishing water in Patagonia.

Sometimes explosive, always challenging, fishing for sea trout requires a level of skill, watercraft and understanding that can frustrate the average salmon angler. However, armed with the correct knowledge to unlock these secrets, the fishing on the Rio Gallegos can be immensely rewarding. ## LA BUITERAS LODGE

### The Area

The Rio Gallegos River is nearly 300kms in length and has its origin in the Southern Andes with two pristine and very beautiful streams, the Penitente and the Ruebens. Winding its way through the wild Patagonian landscape it emerges into the surprisingly mountainous area that encompasses the Las Buiteras beats, some 40kms from the river mouth. The flood plain that lies between these outcrops teems with birdlife, alongside large numbers of rheas, silver foxes, hares and guanaco.

### Las Buiteras Lodge

The lodge is a traditional estancia house which has been recently renovated and consists of five double and two single bedrooms, all with en-suite baths or showers. Clean and functional it makes for a perfect, relaxing environment to unwind after a days fishing.

House wines and beers are in plentiful supply or indeed should the urge arise you may choose to indulge in something special from the well-stocked cellar. For those wishing to maintain a trim waistline beware because our chef is not only a master but also incredibly versatile! You will enjoy some simply excellent cuisine ranging from traditionally barbecued Argentinean meat feasts to fresh sushi with all the oriental complements.

### Loop Tackle Service

As a Loop sponsored and run lodge, Las Buiteras is used as a field testing station for the latest range of Loop rods, lines and reels. Guests are invited to trial or borrow the gear during your stay and assisted by world-class casting instructor, Klaus Frimour, your techniques can be honed to perfection during your stay.

### Wise Men Tips

Take full advantage of your time in Patagonia and extend your stay with three day packages to fish for steelhead on the Santa Cruz River, huge rainbow trout at Jurassic Lake (also in Argentina) or king salmon in Chile. Further details are available on request.

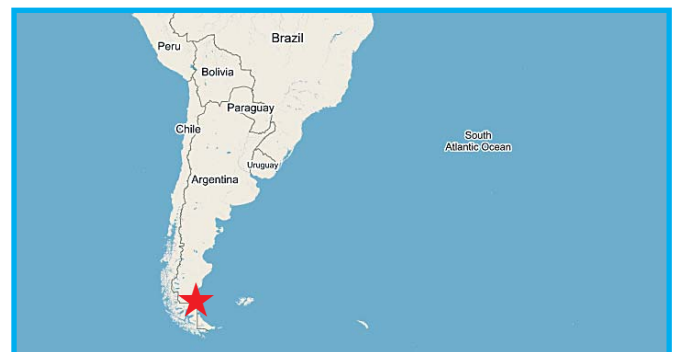
Clothing: **Chest waders combined with a mix of warm wind-proof clothing**
