TROUT FISHING: LOUGH ERNE AND LOUGH MELVIN

The Fermanagh Lakeland is one of the most scenic areas of Ireland that not only provides some of the best wild Trout fishing but also the chance of catching Atlantic Salmon. This fishing package offers you not only the chance to enjoy some excellent fishing,

TROUT FISHING: LOUGH NEAGH BROWN TROUT

Lough Neagh is the largest natural freshwater lake in the British Isles covering an area of 153 square miles. The rivers feeding Lough Neagh are where the visiting angler can catch the wild Brown Trout peculiar to this system, known as "the dollaghan". These

wild Trout can grow to over 10lbs and run the rivers to spawn from July onwards, much like Sea Trout.



TROUT AND SALMON FISHING: LOUGHS CONN & CULLIN

From wild Brownies to Sea Trout, from Salmon to Rainbows, this area of Mayo offers it all, as well as some excellent sea fly fishing for Bass and Mullet. Lough Conn and Cullin provides the visiting angler the chance to fish for superb wild fish on the fly and our guides will give

you every chance of catching as many fish as possible by putting you in the best areas and advising you as to the best flies.



SALMON AND TROUT FISHING: THE CAUSEWAY COAST
