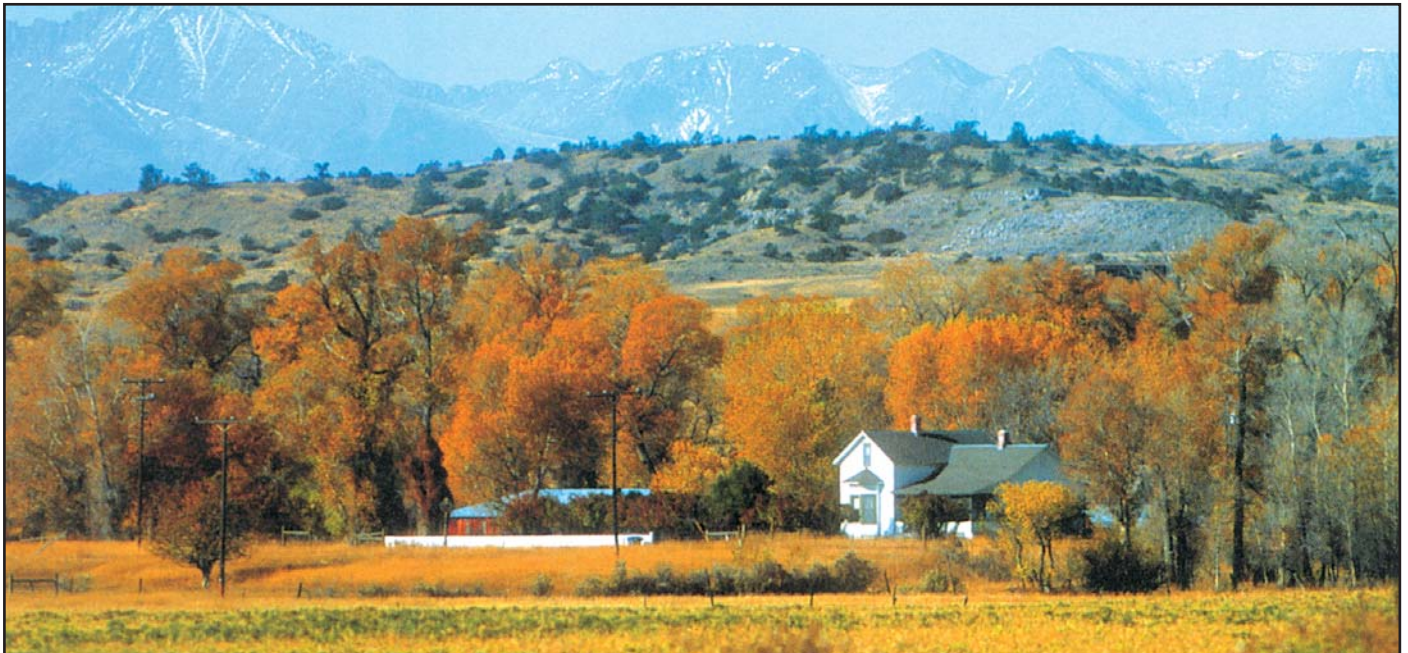

The ranch, located on the banks of the Yellowstone River, with a mile of river frontage, will be your home during your stay. At the centre of the ranch is the **Harrison Homestead**, the oldest home in Sweetgrass county, and recently placed on the National Historic Register. Completely renovated in 2001, the homestead accommodates up to six anglers in rustic elegance with all meals cooked by our personal chef.

## The Area

The Harrison Homestead is situated in the heart of Montana's blue ribbon trout water. The lodge is located on the banks of the Yellowstone River and Sweetgrass Creek with over a mile of river frontage on the Yellowstone. The Harrison Homestead is protected by a conservation easement and is home to a remarkable population of deer, upland birds, raptors, and waterfowl.

The landscape is a mix of fertile river valleys lined with groves of cottonwoods, willow, wide open meadows, and upland sagebrush country. The Crazy, Absarokee and Beartooth mountain ranges are visible from the lodge.

This is truly where the mountains meet the prairie and is a very special part of Montana that is a real joy to fish in.

## The Harrison Homestead Lodge

We have designed our Montana package around a magnificently restored farmhouse, the Harrison Homestead. As the name indicates, the Homestead enjoys a rich history which has prompted its placement on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Homestead is a peaceful, relaxing and enjoyable home located in the middle of a very pastoral setting. The rooms are large, charming and authentically re-furnished. Each room comfortably accommodates two anglers. The dining room and living room are both comfortable and well furnished with pieces from the era.

Season: **April to October**

Fish Species: **Rainbow, brown and cut-throat trout**

Tackle: **A 3 to 5 weight rod for trout with floating line is best. We can provide tackle on request**

Clothing: **Warm fleece, chest waders, hiking boots, lightweight waterproof jacket, sunglasses and a floatation jacket are all recommended**

Package includes:

- **Six nights accommodation**
- **Five and a half days guided fly fishing (based on two anglers per guide)**
- **Float trips on the Yellowstone River**
- **All transport to rivers and spring creeks**
- **All meals, beer, wine and soft drinks**

Lodge Capacity: **Six anglers**
